

JOSHUA PRAYER-WALKING GUIDE

DAY 1 (ROUND 1) [Praise Songs ROUND 7]

El Roi [el ROY] – *The God Who Sees*

I praise You, for You see me and know me. You hear my voice. You know right where I am and have placed me here. You have a plan for my *friends, family and neighbors*. You know our future purposes and designs. You have called us by name.

Elohim [el-o-HEEM] – *The Creator and Triune God*. I praise You for your great love and mercy for us, making us alive in Christ, even though we were dead in sin. Thank you Father for the Third Person of the Holy Spirit who teaches us all things and reminds us of everything Jesus said. I ask You, Jesus, to fill us, my *family, friends, and neighbors*, with Your Holy Spirit and lead in Truth.

DAY 2 (ROUND 2)

Jehovah-Tsidkenu [juh-HO-vah Tzid-KAY-noo] – *The Lord Our Righteousness*

I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature, but I confess and praise You for removing my stony heart and replacing it with a heart that is God-willed, not self-willed. I ask you do this for all my *family, friends, and neighbors*. I lift up the blood of Jesus over all.

Jehovah-Shalom [juh-HO-vah Shah-LOME] – *The Lord is Peace*

Thank you for giving me an instructed tongue, saying peace, peace to all who are far off and to him that is near. You keep us in perfect peace because our mind is stayed on You. We will have no fear of bad news; our heart is fixed, steadfast, trusting in You. I pray my *family, friends and neighbors* will find peace in You, Jehovah-Shalom.

DAY 3 (ROUND 3)

Jehovah-Rohi [juh-HO-vah ROW ee] – *The Lord My Shepherd*

I roll my works upon You, committing them and trusting them to You knowing my plans will be established and succeed. Thank you for leading me (the blind) by ways I have not known, along unfamiliar paths, guiding continually. Turn darkness into light and make rough places smooth for my family, friends and neighbors.

El Shaddai [el-shaw-DIE] – *The All Sufficient One*
I praise You God Almighty for Your promises of increase; fruitfulness; protection; deliverance from bondage; and promise of a homeland, purpose and heaven.

DAY 4 (ROUND 4)

Jehovah-Jireh [juh-HO-vah JI-rah] – *The Lord's Provision Will Be Seen*

You have created us and see us. You have formed us. We will fear not, for we have been redeemed. We are summoned by name. We belong to God. When we pass through the waters, You are with us; and when we pass through the rivers, they will not sweep over us. When we walk through the fire, we will not be burned; the flames will not set us ablaze.

Jehovah-Rapha [juh-HO-vah RAH-fah] – *The Lord is Healer*

I thank you Lord that You are the Healer. You bore our sins in Your body on the tree, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness: by Jesus' wounds we have been healed (1 Peter 2:24). Christ redeemed me from the curse of the law by becoming a curse for us (Gal. 3:13). I claim You as Healer for *family, friends and neighbors*.

DAY 5 (ROUND 5)

El Elyon [el EL-yuhn] – *The God Most High*

Thank you for being the possessor of heaven and earth, who has delivered our enemies into our hand. Everything You do is right and all Your ways are just—trustworthy and true—always faithful to Your promises. You have made us salt and light; keep us in the world but not of it.

Jehovah-Sabaoth [juh-HO-vah sah-bah-OATH] – *The Lord of hosts*

You are Supreme Commander of the universe and our bridegroom; therefore, we shall not be shaken. We shall speak and publish the Good News in a 100% committed partnership with You. We watch and wait for You as we make Your mission ours.

DAY 6 (ROUND 6)

Jehovah – The LORD: Yahweh [YAH-way]

/Yeshua [YESH u wa]—So holy a name, Jehovah—Your fire bringing down walls, facades, and hidden secrets of the heart. Thank you for removing masks once worn. Keep us real, *being* ever filled with Your Spirit, as we walk and run in Your name as end-time harvesters.

Jehovah-Shammah [juh-HO-vah SHAHM-mah] – *The LORD is There*

Thank you LORD for being there and here. You are my strength, my personal bravery and my invincible army; You make my feet like hind's feet, and will make me to walk [not stand still in terror] and make spiritual progress upon my high places [of trouble, suffering or responsibility] (Hab. 3:19 AMP).
